2021 PROGRAM RESULTS

Transition2Work improves workers' compensation outcomes by connecting injured workers with nonprofits for meaningful transitional duty. By combining business and community, our return to work solutions help control the rising cost of claims while positively influencing the lives of employees and contributing to the community.

In 2021, many companies and nonprofits shifted the way they do business. As the industry leader, ReEmployAbility adapted by expanding the Work from Home program with additional remote work opportunities while still securing assignments at nonprofit locations throughout the nation. Collaborating with our network of nonprofits, ReEmployAbility provides programs with flexible options including onsite, remote, and even nonprofit assignments at the employers' worksite. Transition2Work offers meaningful return-to-work for injured workers while utilizing their capabilities, safely within COVID-19 protocols.
