To date, Transition2Work participants have collectively dedicated an estimated 18.4 million volunteer hours to local and national nonprofit organizations.

#### **ECONOMIC CONTRIBUTION**



Participants in the Transition2Work program have made a significant economic contribution to nonprofit organizations, with an approximate impact exceeding \$484 million.

### POSITIVE CONTRIBUTIONS

Transition2Work participants generously contribute nearly 400 hours of their time and skills to support nonprofit organizations, amounting to an average participation of 57 days.

#### **PARTICIPATION RATE**

54% of referred injured workers actively engage in a purposeful Transition2Work assignment.

RTW programs are part of a holistic recovery program for injured workers with Worker's Compensation claims, enabling companies to "Recover the Worker" during the claims process. Transition 2 Work integrates a full-person approach to medically appropriate light & modified-duty.
