We're excited to showcase Transition2Work's positive impact on communities, injured employees, carriers, and employers.

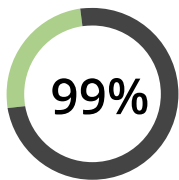

Injured Workers Find Purpose and Positivity in Transition2Work

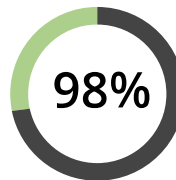
